Alert Summary: This alert is to inform you of changes being made to the General Foundations training plan and Ethics trainings available on Relias eLearning.

Dear Optum Idaho Providers,

The Optum Idaho Education and Training team has updated the General Foundations training plan which is required for some providers to be endorsed to provide Target Care Coordination and Skills Training and Development.

The training plan has been revised to include current trainings that are interactive and provide a more comprehensive overview of foundational topics needed for working within the behavioral health field. This new plan will go into effect September 1, 2022.
