March 6, 2023

Alert Summary: This alert reminds providers that unit counts for threshold services will begin after the conclusion of the Public Health Emergency (PHE) on May 11, 2023.

Dear Provider,

Thank you for serving our members during the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency (PHE). During the PHE, the Idaho Division of Medicaid directed Optum Idaho to pause the threshold authorization requirements for certain services (see <u>April 17, 2020 provider alert</u>). When the PHE ends on May 11, 2023, Medicaid has directed Optum Idaho to bring back the threshold authorization requirements.

On May 12, 2023, the thresholds will restart for the following services:

- Extended office visits 90837, 90838 (12 units/year)
- Case Management T1017 (240 units/year)
- Skills Building/CBRS (308 units/year) (See Skills Building/CBRS provider alert)
- Peer Services
 - Peer Support H0038 (416 units/year)
 - Youth Support H0038 (416 units/year)
 - o Recovery Coaching H0038 HF (416 units/year)
 - o Family Support H0046 (416 units/year)

Units used before May 12, 2023 will not count toward the thresholds. The units for these services are provided per member and per calendar year: thresholds will be renewed annually. These services, like all services, should be provided only when medically necessary. When additional services are required, they must be requested in advance of the provision of the services.
